

<u>Brief History of Butler County Stockman's Association Production Sale</u> For several years, agriculture leaders discussed building an agriculture exposition center in Butler County.

In 2006, a group of Extension Service volunteers began working with local civic leaders to make the building become a reality. Leaders worked to gather input on what the community wanted in such a facility. A plan was developed and the first phase of the Ag. Exposition Center was constructed. Both public and private funds were used for the project.

In late 2010, the latest phase of what is now the Eva J. Hawes Ag. Exposition and Community Center was finished. The finished meeting space, kitchen facilities, and bathrooms make the building truly versatile.

Several members of the Butler County Stockman's Association decided to hold a production sale and utilize the new Ag Exposition Center. They worked to raise money to purchase the livestock handling equipment used for the sale and other livestock events.

In March of 2011, the first annual Butler County Stockman's Association Beef Cattle Production sale was the first event held in the new Ag. Exposition Center. The sale was a big success. An incredible amount of volunteer time and energy went into holding the event.

The Agriculture Exposition Center is a great example of what can be accomplished through cooperation. City and county government worked together with local volunteers, private businesses, private donors, agriculture groups, grant funding agencies, and the UK Cooperative Extension Service to build our Ag. Exposition Center. It has been used for a variety of purposes including, livestock events, Farm Bureau annual meetings, various trainings, family reunions, and more. Rental information is available at City Hall on Main Street in Morgantown.
